USP Class VI Certification

Accura® ClearVue™ material has met the requirements of USP Class VI testing. This conclusion is based on the animal testing of parts produced from a single batch of Accura® ClearVue™ material on a Viper™ SLA® System using the 3D Systems' EXACT build styles and the preferred cleaning methods outlined in the company's Customer Information Bulletin for Accura® ClearVue™ material, which should be read together with this Regulatory Information Sheet. The company believes that the testing referred to above is representative of parts produced with Accura® ClearVue™ material on all stereolithography machines offered by 3D Systems using its EXACT build styles so long as the produced parts are cleaned in accordance with the methods described in the Customer Information Bulletin referred to above.

Based on these results, 3D Systems expects that similar articles made from this material, under similar conditions and produced using good manufacturing practices in accordance with 3D Systems' recommendations, will meet the compliance requirements of USP Class VI.

In any case, it is the responsibility of each customer to determine that its use of Accura® ClearVue™ material is safe, lawful and technically suitable to the customer's intended applications. Customers should conduct their own testing to ensure that this is the case. Because of possible changes in the law and in regulations, as well as possible changes in Accura® ClearVue™ material, 3D Systems cannot guarantee that the status of Accura® ClearVue™ material will remain unchanged or that it will qualify for USP Class VI Certification in any particular use. Therefore, 3D Systems recommends that customers continuing to use Accura® ClearVue™ material verify its status no less frequently than every two years from the date of this publication.
